The Matric Courses at Oxbridge Academy are designed for students who did not complete Matric at school. The aim of these courses is to give students the opportunity to reach the academic level that they need to continue with their studies at N4-level.

# FOUNDATIONAL LEARNING COMPETENCE (PART QUALIFICATION)

Foundational Learning refers to the competence needed in the two key areas of Communication and Mathematical Literacy in order to deal successfully with occupational learning at NQF Levels 2-4. Its key purpose is to remove barriers to learning and progress in occupational pathways and skills development.

## ASSESSMENT

Each learning area is assessed separately **ON THE SAME DAY**. Each assessment is 2.5 hours long and consists of 60 multiple-choice questions. Assessments are machine scored.

The IEB will issue a statement of results to FLC Skills Development Providers. The IEB will upload learner results to the QCTO. Learners need to be found competent in both learning areas in order to achieve the part qualification.

# SENIOR CERTIFICATE OPTIONS

At Oxbridge Academy, we have two options for students who wish to obtain their Matric Certificates:

- National Senior Certificate Rewrites
- Senior Certificate (as amended)

The **National Senior Certificate Rewrite** option is recommended for students who attempted and failed Matric from 2008 onwards or students who want to improve their marks in order to gain access to university. The course content will consist of the CAPS curriculum. To gain entry to this programme, students need valid school-based assessments (SBAs).

The **Senior Certificate (as amended)** option is available to students who are 21 and older and wish to complete Matric. Students need to register for a minimum of six subjects, two of which must be official languages. One of the languages must be taken at Home Language level and the other as a First Additional Language.

A Senior Certificate will be achieved by an adult candidate who meets the following requirements in these exams:

1. Pass three subjects at 40%, one of which must be an official language at Home Language level.
2. Pass two subjects at 30%, one of which must be an official language at First Additional or Home Language level.
3. Obtain a subminimum of 20% in the sixth subject.

# NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE REWRITES

If you failed Matric or would like to redo a subject to improve your marks in order to gain access to university, you've come to the right place! To be eligible to register for these subjects and qualify for your national senior certificate, you need to have completed your academic year in 2008 and onwards.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify to register for a Senior Certificate (as amended), candidates need to be over the age of 21 and have either:

- a Grade 9/Standard 7 report stating they passed the year, OR
- a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC), OR
- a recognised equivalent obtained at NQF level 1 which requires two official languages.

Candidates may also register if they have an incomplete Senior Certificate or if their School-Based Assessment (SBA) has expired.
